

SPARK ORGANZA

Also referred to as "Dazzle Cloth" or "Twinkle Cloth", Spark Organza is an easy way to incorporate a light and airy look to a design. It comes in a wide range of colours and is available from material shops.

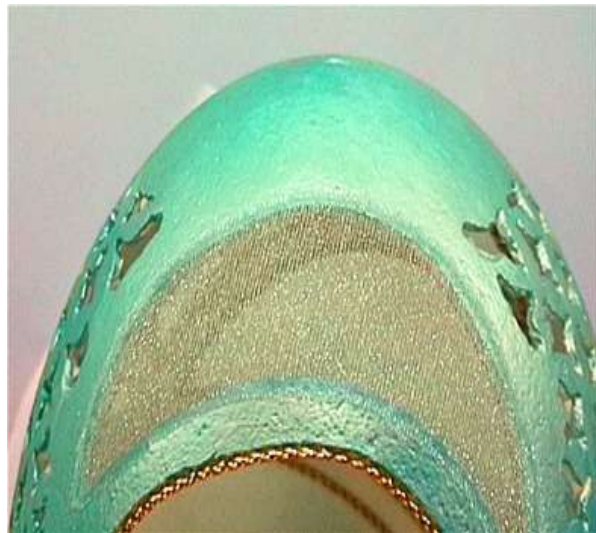
If you plan on following along with the class you will need to prepare your egg with the desired cut-outs and paint the egg ready to decorate it.

Basic Procedure

Cut and paint the egg in accordance with design instructions.

NOTE: The material should be applied to the egg with the straight of the grain (i.e. no stretch) going from top to bottom in the cut-out portion of the design.

- Keeping the above note in mind cut a piece of organza slightly larger than the area you wish to cover.
- Apply a very fine line of tacky glue all around the edge of the cutout area, carefully position the organza and gently press onto the glue. Be careful not to use too much glue as it may spread onto the material.



Hint: a glue bottle with a stainless steel tip makes the glue application much easier.

Allow the glue to "set up" for a little while before trimming away the excess material with a small pair of sharp scissors. A pair with a curved blade makes it easier to get up really close.

Apply cord, thread or braid of your choice to
